

**Resolution of Intention to Consider Changes to
Cannabis Regulations Pursuant to Recent Changes in State Law**

1. Whereas, the City of Sebastopol has comprehensive regulations pertaining to several classes of medical cannabis uses; and
2. Whereas, the State of California has recently enacted new discretionary standards for medical cannabis uses that the City of Sebastopol could consider allowing; and
3. Whereas, the voters of the State of California recently enacted allowances for non-medical sale of cannabis, and
4. Several area jurisdictions have enacted new regulations pursuant to these changes in State law; and
5. It is appropriate for the City of Sebastopol to review these new regulations and consider if there is a need to update the City's regulations; and
6. The Planning Commission has a role in advising the City Council regarding land use regulations.

Now, therefore, the City Council does hereby adopt this Resolution of Intention announcing the intention to consider revisions to its cannabis regulations, and directing the Planning Commission to initiate a public process to draft appropriate recommended Zoning Ordinance provisions.
