

RESOLUTION NO. 5936

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SEBASTOPOL AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 1769
ESTABLISHING RATES FOR SEWER SERVICE

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Sebastopol did adopt Resolution No. 1769, dated November 17, 1969 which established sewer service charges to customers serviced by the City of Sebastopol; and

WHEREAS, in order to meet State discharge requirements and in accordance with State Revenue Program guidelines it is necessary to revise the charges heretofore established; and

WHEREAS, on August 7, 2012, the City Council adopted updated sewer service rates by Resolution No. 5887; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined the rates listed in Table 5 of Resolution No. 5887 need to be amended; and

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that the City Council does approve the following amended sewer rates effective July 1, 2012, and approves amendment of Section 10.B(a) and Section 10.B(d) of Resolution No. 1769 to be revised to read as follows:

RATES FOR SEWER SERVICE:

A. Volume Rates: Sewer services charges for the various non-industrial user shall be based on the following rates:

There are additional charges for water usage over 100 cubic feet. Table 4 below provides the current and approved future rates for that usage. Additional charges do no occur until usage reaches a full 100 cubic feet beyond the first 100 cubic feet.

B. Minimum Charge: The minimum charge for each user separate dwelling unit, space in mobile home park, separate business establishment, or suite of offices, shall be \$8.06 for each bi-monthly billing period. There shall also be a minimum standby charge for each

metered connection that shall pay for the first 100 cubic feet of discharge during the period. The minimum standby charge shall be used based on meter size and shall be charged at the following bi-monthly rates:

Minimum sewer charges are made on a rate per 100 cubic feet of water basis. The current bi-monthly minimums and the rates with the approved rate increase are shown in Table 5 below.
